Letter to Households for Community Eligibility Provision Schools

We are pleased to inform families that the Elk Grove Unified School District's Food & Nutrition Services department will provide the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) program through the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs during the 2020-21 school year.

Schools that participate in the CEP are able to provide healthy breakfasts and lunches each day at no charge for all students enrolled in that CEP school during the 2020-21 School Year.
